Acknowledgement for PLAYER _____ (name of player):

I understand and accept that the Sherwood Park Ringette Association (SPRA), SPRA approved coaches, assistant coaches, managers, team staff, or members of the Association, its executives/affiliates/spouses, or its sponsors are not responsible for any matter, cause or accident, which may occur during the period covered by this registration. On behalf of my child, I give permission to the SPRA to photograph and/or record my child, and/or my child's voice/image on photographs, audio tape and/or video tape and to use this material, through television, film, Internet, multi-media presentation, radio, audiotape, videotape or in printed form or display form for the promotion of SPRA, and the sport of Ringette.

I assign and transfer to SPRA any and all rights, including copyright, which I may have or my child may have in this material for the 2011/2012 season. I also understand the following:

1. Participation may include travel and staying in commercial accommodation which are not covered by registration fees.
2. Registration fees **DO NOT** include costs such as tournaments, equipment, extra ice, fundraising etc.
3. Game locations and schedules are not determined by SPRA. Each team must abide by the schedule as dictated by either the Black Gold League, Zone 5 AA, or Ringette Alberta. Game schedules take precedence over tournaments or team sponsored/arranged events. Failure to play a scheduled game may result in a fine that is the team's responsibility to cover payment.
4. Association's insurance only covers registered players and team staff.
5. Coaches have the authority to restrict players' game play if they are delinquent or fail to wear required equipment.
6. Coaches or managers must be advised in writing of any medication or other health-related information required to ensure good player health.
7. NSF cheques are subject to \$50 administration fee (per incident)
8. My participation, and, if applicable, the participation of my spouse is an integral part of my child's participation in SPRA. Membership in SPRA is not as an individual but rather as one family unit. Accordingly if I, or, if applicable my spouse, are no longer willing or able to fully support my child's participation in SPRA my child may no longer be permitted to attend SPRA events.
9. I am aware of and will abide by the Code of Conduct: (see Appendix A in SPRA Guidelines & Procedures Manual).

ACKNOWLEDGMENT, WAIVER AND RELEASE

Certain volunteers to Sherwood Park Ringette Association are required to complete a Criminal Records Check and a Vulnerable Sectors search with the local RCMP. It is our understanding that the Vulnerable Sectors search is to confirm whether or not an individual has ever been pardoned for having committed a sexual offence. We are informed that out of an abundance of caution, the RCMP set the search criteria under the Vulnerable Sector search very broadly and, as a result, there is a high number of matches found under this search. We are informed that a confirmation search is required in order to verify whether or not an individual has a record under the Vulnerable Sector search. This confirmation search requires an individual to provide their fingerprints and a search fee. The actual search can take anywhere from four weeks to nine months. Given these factors, Sherwood Park Ringette Association has decided not to insist upon individuals that have a Vulnerable Sectors hit to complete the fingerprint application. In lieu of completing the fingerprint application, all individuals that have a hit on the Vulnerable Sectors search are requested to sign an affidavit confirming that they have no record of any criminal convictions (a copy of the form of affidavit is available for review upon request).

There are some obvious attendant risks to not obtaining the fingerprint search which you as a parent should be aware of. By signing below, you are acknowledging that you are aware of the possible risks to your child and that you waive any and all rights to make any claim against Sherwood Park Ringette Association, its directors, officers and employees resulting from any harm that may come to your child as a result of the Sherwood Park Ringette Association not having followed all of the available background checks for its volunteers.
